



Product Care and Maintenance

DO'S AND DON'TS FOR CLEANING

Do's:

1. Clean your Whitewater product (wall surrounds, glass enclosures, shower floors, acrylic bathtubs, quartz countertop) regularly with a *mild, non-abrasive cleaner* (Scrubbing Bubbles, Doterra On Guard, Mrs. Meyers, etc.) and a soft microfiber cloth or sponge.
2. After using shower or bathtub, remove excess water with squeegee after every use to prevent hard water spots. This is a good practice for glass enclosures and wall surrounds.
3. If there are any stains or soap scum buildup, use a mixture of baking soda and water to remove.
4. If using a new product for cleaning, test it first in an inconspicuous area to make sure that it doesn't cause any damage to product.
5. Use a trivet or hot pad when putting hot items on quartz countertop. Quartz is heat resistant, but can still be harmed by high heat.
6. Clean your products regularly for them to look their best.

Don'ts:

1. *Avoid using abrasive scrubbers, steel wool, or harsh chemicals*, as these can scratch or damage the surface of wall surrounds, shower floors, glass enclosures, and quartz countertops.
2. Do not use acidic cleaners, as these can etch the surface and cause damage.
3. Do not leave dye or other strong chemicals on the surface, as they can cause permanent discoloration.
4. Do not place hot items directly on quartz countertops or shower floors, as this can cause cracks or other damage.
5. Do not use bleach or ammonia-based cleaners on the wall surrounds or shower floors, as these can cause yellowing or discoloration.

RECOMMENDED CLEANING PRODUCTS:

- Non-abrasive cleaner (Scrubbing Bubbles, Mrs. Meyers, Doterra On Guard, Windex)
- Microfiber cloths, soft sponges
- Squeegee
